BRIEF REPORT	Under the aegis of IQAC, a 'Free Health Check-up Camp' was organized on 29 th September, 2025, at the premise of Bhimadevi

	Temple, Bhiwapur. The Camp was conducted under ‘Late Bhausaheb Mulak Students’ Welfare and Social Service Scheme of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya’, in association with ‘Bhiwapur Medical Association’, ‘Shri Bhimadevi Yuvak Seva Mandal’, and ‘Govt. Primary Health Centre, Somnala’. Experienced Doctors contributed their services to make this initiative successful. During the Camp, ‘Ayushman Bharat’ scheme cards were also issued to eligible beneficiaries. A total of 403 patients were examined with the help of 14 Doctors and 18 paramedical staff members. Free medicines were distributed to the needy patients. The Camp was organized under the guidance of Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of our College. The initiative received valuable support from medical experts including Dr. Madhusudan Kothalkar, Dr. Santosh Raut, Dr. Pradeep Gupta, Dr. Varsha Gupta, Dr. Jayshree Raut, Dr. Shweta Gupta, Dr. Yogesh Bokade, Dr. Hivarkar, Dr. Korde, Dr. Dipali Chandekar, Dr. Rahul Raut, and Dr. Bhavana Jasudkar. All the members of teaching and non-teaching staff, along with students of our College, have actively participated in the Camp.

PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	Organizing the Camp involved several logistical challenges, including managing a high patient turnout, coordinating multiple stakeholders, and ensuring smooth patient flow. The Committee addressed crowd management by setting up multiple counters and deploying volunteers. Coordination among Doctors and staff was handled through prior planning, clear role allocation, and regular communication. Medicine availability was ensured through advance estimation and efficient distribution. Documentation for ‘Ayushman Bharat’ cards posed delays, which were managed by creating a separate help desk. Space and

	infrastructure constraints at the venue were resolved through temporary arrangements and proper layout planning. Overall, effective planning and teamwork ensured the smooth execution of the Camp.
