DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	The 'Students' Guidance & Placement Cell' of our College, under the aegis of 'Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)', organized an 'Investor Awareness Programme' on 9th October, 2025 in association with the 'National Stock Exchange (NSE)', to promote financial literacy among students. The Session witnessed an enthusiastic participation of 74 students. The Keynote Address was delivered by Mr. Shashant Mishra, Officer-in-Charge, NSE Nagpur. Other distinguished members from NSE present at the Event included Mr. Badal Wasnik, Mr. Sumit Karwade, both are the members of NSE and Mr. Himanshu Yadav-Intern of NSE. Presiding over the Event, Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of Bhiwapur Mahavidyalaya, emphasized the importance of

	financial education for youth in today's rapidly changing economic environment. He encouraged the students to develop sound investment habits and to understand the fundamentals of the Securities Market as part of their personal and professional growth. PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	Organizing an ‘Investor Awareness Programme’ of this scale, in collaboration with a reputed institution like the ‘National Stock Exchange’, involved several practical and coordination-related challenges. One of the primary difficulties was scheduling and coordination with NSE Officials. Aligning the availability of Resource Persons such as Mr. Shashant Mishra and other representatives while ensuring maximum student participation required careful planning. The committee addressed this through early communication, flexible scheduling, and continuous follow-ups. Another challenge was students’ engagement and awareness. Encouraging students-especially those from non-commerce backgrounds-to attend a finance-oriented Session, was not easy. The Organizing Committee overcame this by conducting pre-event promotions, classroom announcements, and emphasizing the relevance of financial literacy in everyday life. Through proactive planning, teamwork, and effective communication, the Committee successfully navigated these challenges, resulting in a well-organized and impactful Programme.
