DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	Institutional ‘Committee for Promoting Research, Innovation, Extension and Consultancy Services’, under the auspices of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), organized a One-Day Workshop on "Research Paper Writing: Structure, Style and Ethics" On 23rd December, 2025. The Workshop was specially designed for newly appointed faculty members, newly registered research scholars, Postgraduate students, and aspiring to publish research papers in reputed National and International Journals. The objective of the Programme was to familiarize the participants with every stage of scientific manuscript preparation from selecting a research topic to publishing in peer-reviewed Research Journals while emphasizing research integrity, ethical publishing practices, and responsible authorship. The Workshop witnessed enthusiastic participation from research scholars, faculty members, and Postgraduate students representing various science disciplines. The Programme commenced with the traditional lighting of the lamp and Saraswati Vandana, symbolizing the pursuit of knowledge and wisdom. The dignitaries were welcomed with floral bouquets and shawls. The Programme began with a warm welcome address by the coordinator, who emphasized the significance of scientific writing in academic research. The Principal highlighted that quality research gains recognition only when communicated effectively through well-written publications. He encouraged the participants to maintain originality, honesty, and ethical standards throughout their research careers. The inaugural session concluded with an overview of the day's

Programme and an introduction of the Resource Person.

Technical Session I

Research Paper Writing: Structure of a Scientific Manuscript

The Resource Person explained the complete framework of a research paper using practical examples. The participants learned the purpose and preparation of each section, including;

- Selection of an appropriate research title
- Writing an informative abstract
- Choosing effective keywords
- Preparing a comprehensive introduction
- Literature review and identification of research gaps
- Materials and Methods
- Presentation of Results
- Discussion and interpretation of findings
- Conclusion and future scope
- Acknowledgements
- References

Special emphasis was placed on logical organization, coherence, clarity, and scientific accuracy.

Technical Session II

Academic Writing Style and Scientific Communication

During this session, participants learned effective techniques of scientific writing. The speaker discussed;

- Principles of clear and concise writing
- Use of formal academic language
- Grammar and sentence construction
- Scientific vocabulary
- Avoiding unnecessary repetition

	• Preparing informative tables and figures • Writing captions and legends • Effective data presentation • Writing impactful conclusions Examples from published research papers were analyzed to demonstrate best writing practices. The Valedictory Programme was concluded with a summary of the day's learning outcomes. PROBLEMS FACED, IF ANY	• Time constraints limited in-depth discussion of all the topics. • Participants had varying levels of prior knowledge, requiring additional explanations on some concepts. • Limited time was available for individual interaction and manuscript review. • Some participants experienced minor technical issues while accessing online research databases and reference management tools. • Despite these minor challenges, the Workshop was conducted successfully, and the objectives were achieved effectively.
