DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	The Department of English of our College, under the aegis of IQAC, organized a subject-based Quiz Competition on 11th March 2026 for the students of English language and English literature. The Event was organized under the banner of 'Subject Literary Association of English'. The objective of this activity was to develop greater interest among students in English language and literature, enhance their subject knowledge, and encourage a competitive spirit. The Programme was conducted under the guidance of Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of our College. The 'Quiz Competition' included questions related to subject knowledge as well as general knowledge. Questions were presented effectively using audio-visual aids. A total of 12 students from first, second, and third year participated in the competition. They were divided into four groups, with three students in each group. The Quiz was conducted in four rounds. The first round consisted of subject-based questions. In the second round, questions were asked based on images. The third round included questions based on video clips, while the fourth round focused on listening skills. All these rounds made the competition more engaging and informative. A total of 46 students attended the Programme. In the final results, Group 'D' secured first place with 180 Marks. Group 'A' secured second place with 160 Marks. Group 'B' secured third

	place with 130 Marks, while Group ‘C’ stood fourth with 75 Marks. The winning Group ‘D’ included Ms. Sejal Baghel, Ms. Muskan Maraskolhe, and Ms. Vaishnavi Titarmare. The Programme was anchored by Associate Prof. Dr. R.K. Quraishi, Head, Department of English. Asst. Prof. Dr. Someshwar Wasekar and Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita Virgandham also provided valuable support in successfully organizing the Event. Certificates were issued to all the participants and winning Team Members. With the generous financial contribution of Associate Prof. Dr. R. K. Quraishi, Asst. Prof. Dr. Someshwar Wasekar, and Asst. Prof. Dr. Vinita Virgandham, the winning team was presented with a cash prize of ₹1500, during the Annual Day Function, at the hands of Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of our College.

Varied rounds like image, video, and listening, made the Quiz interactive. Financial constraints for prizes were resolved through faculty contributions. Overall, effective planning and teamwork helped overcome these challenges and ensured a smooth execution.
