BRIEF REPORT	During the ‘Annual Day Function-Umang 2026’, the Department of Physical Education and Sports, under the aegis of IQAC, organized ‘Sports Excellence Felicitation & Merit Incentive Programme’ to recognize and encourage students who excelled in sports at Inter-Collegiate, State, National, and International levels during the academic year 2025-2026. The primary objective of this initiative was to appreciate the achievements of student athletes and motivate them to continue striving for excellence in their respective sports disciplines. A key highlight of the Programme was the generous contribution of our esteemed Management, ‘Backward Class Youth Relief Committee, Khamla, Nagpur’, which sponsored cash prizes with a vision to promote sports talent in the rural region of Bhiwapur. Under this initiative, students who secured Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals in various competitions were honoured with financial incentives as a token of appreciation. Gold medalists were awarded ₹3,000, Silver medalists received ₹2,000, and Bronze medalists were given ₹1,000 through cheque. In addition to the monetary rewards, the Institution extended further support to these meritorious sportspersons by waiving their total admission fees, thereby fostering both their academic and athletic development. A total of 18 students were benefited from this initiative, with a cumulative amount of ₹41,000 disbursed.
