	Day State Level Teachers' Workshop on the theme "<i>Current Trends in Research</i>" on 17th October, 2025 at 12:00 pm. The Programme was aimed to enhance the Research capabilities of faculty members and provide insights into emerging directions and methodologies in Academic Research. The Workshop commenced with a formal Inauguration Ceremony. Dr. Jobi George, the Principal of our College, presided over the Programme, with Asso. Prof. Dr. Anita Mahawadiwar, the IQAC Co-ordinator, sharing the Dias. The highlight of the Programme was the Expert Session delivered by the Resource Person, Dr. Samit Mahore, Associate Professor, Department of Economics and Director of the Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University. In his address, Dr. Samit Mahore elaborated on contemporary developments in Research across disciplines. He emphasized the importance of interdisciplinary approaches, ethical Research practices, and the integration of technology in Modern Research Methodologies. 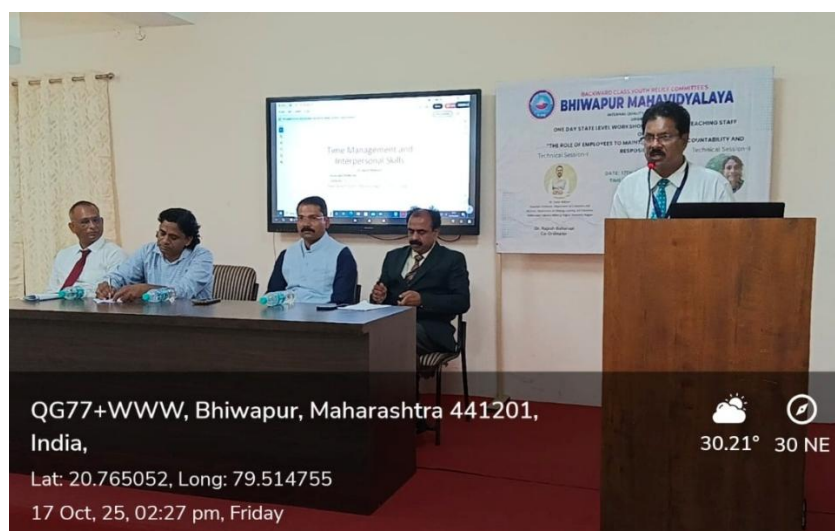
