DETAILED REPORT OF THE ACTIVITY	The Department of Chemistry, under the aegis of its 'Subject Literary Association,' organized an 'Ozone Day Celebration' focused at raising awareness about the importance of preserving the Ozone Layer and combating Ozone Depletion. The theme for World Ozone Day observed on 16th September, 2025 was "From Science to Global Action". This theme underscored the Montreal Protocol's pivotal role not only in safeguarding the Ozone Layer but also in driving broader initiatives to combat climate change, the Event brought together students, faculty members, and environmental enthusiasts to commemorate this significant day. On this occasion, the Department successfully conducted a Guest Lecture for the students by Asst. Prof. Amit Thakare from the Department of Zoology. The lecture focused on the environmental challenges posed by Ozone Depletion and the collective efforts to address them. Additionally, a Documentary highlighting these issues was screened for the audience, serving as an eye-opener and fostering a deeper understanding of the urgency to protect our planet's Ozone Layer. The Session covered various aspects of Ozone depletion, including its causes, environmental effects, and measures to mitigate its impact. A total of 34 students actively participated, gaining valuable knowledge and insights. The Event served as a powerful reminder of our collective responsibility to safeguard the Ozone Layer for future generations, reinforcing the

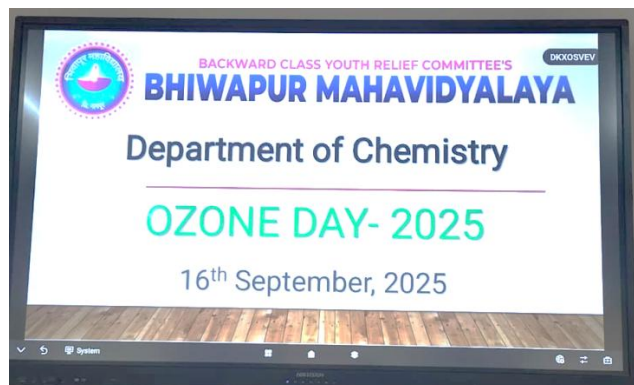
	importance of sustainable environmental practices.
